

## DRESS CODE

Attire is limited to dance wear. Street clothes are prohibited

**Pre-Ballet:** Pink leotard, pink tights and pink ballet slippers.

Kinder Classes: Leotard and tights any style or color.

## **Primary Ballet, Elementary Ballet, Pre-Intensive Ballet:**

- Females: black leotard, any style, pink tights and pink ballet slippers.
- Males: White fitted t-shirt, black tights or jazz pants, black ballet slippers.

## Ballet Intensive 1, Ballet Intensive 2, Ballet Intensive 3 & Pointe:

- **Females**: Black leotard, any style, pink tights and pink ballet slippers.
- Pointe Skirt: short sheer ballet wrap skirt
- Males: White fitted t-shirt, black tights or jazz pants, black ballet slippers.

Other classes: Leotard and tights. Jazz pants and jazz shorts are optional.

Dance wear must be form fitting and in good repair.

Sports-bra style tops are permitted in place of a leotard providing the sports bra measures not less than 3.5 inches under the arm area and not less than 5 inches in the front, from top to bottom. Sports-bra style tops are usually worn with a dance short or leggings. Sports-bra style tops with dance pants/shorts may be worn in tap, jazz, hip hop, acrobatics, and specialty classes. They are prohibited in ballet and pointe.

Dance shorts and pants may not sit lower on the hips than ½ inch below the navel.

Intensive students may wear colored tops and bottoms during the first 7 days of every month, except for Ballet classes.

No jewelry of any type shall be allowed in class, except for stud earrings, small in size.

Hair must be neatly pulled up off neck and away from the face

Shoe style and color shall be determined by Piazza Dance Company (See Universal Shoe List)

Bare feet are allowed in Jazz class, but dancing in socks or stockings without shoes is prohibited

More than 2 warnings for dress code violations shall be cause for dismissal.
